- For our leaders as the Diocese continues the process of choosing a new Bishop of Ely, we pray that the right person will emerge to carry forward the work of Ely 2025 and beyond.
- For this church, for Eleanor, Paula, Jo and all in leadership positions and especially for Virginia preparing for her ordination as Priest on 29th June.
