As the unemployment rate rose to its highest for a year, we pray for those that are job seeking.
- As the exam season draws to a close, many young people are making important decisions for their future. May the Holy Spirit guide them, their families and their mentors in their choices.
- For our leaders as the Diocese continues the process of choosing a new Bishop of Ely, we pray that the right person will emerge to carry forward the work of Ely 2025 and beyond.
- For this church, for Eleanor, Paula, Jo and all in leadership positions and especially for Virginia's ordination as Priest this Saturday, 29th June.
